The Hearing Ear and the Seeing Eye

Prov 20:12 - The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them.

Isa 50:4-5 - 4) The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, <u>he wakeneth mine ear</u> to hear as the learned. 5) The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.

Isa 6:9-10 - 9) And he said, Go, and tell this people, <u>Hear ye indeed, but understand not</u>; and <u>see ye</u> <u>indeed</u>, <u>but perceive not</u>. 10) Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, <u>and hear with their ears</u>, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

Matt 13:14-15 - 14) And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By <u>hearing</u> ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive: 15) For this people's heart is waxed gross, <u>and their ears are dull of hearing</u>, <u>and their eyes they have closed</u>; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

Jer 6:10 - To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? behold, <u>their ear is</u> <u>uncircumcised</u>, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach; they have no delight in it.

Ezek 12:2 - Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.

Zech 7:11 - But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

Acts 7:51 - Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye.

Rom 11:7-8 - 7) What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded 8) (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear:) unto this day.

Mark 4:11-12 - 11) And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: 12) <u>That seeing they may see, and not perceive</u>; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them.

Luke 14:35 - It is neither fit for the land, nor yet for the dunghill; but men cast it out. <u>He that hath ears</u> to hear, let him hear. (see also: Mk. 7:16)

Luke 8:8 - And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare fruit an hundredfold. And when he had said these things, he cried, <u>He that hath ears to hear, let him hear</u>.

Luke 11:28 - But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.

Luke 16:29-31 - 29) Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; <u>let them hear</u> them. 30) And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will

repent. 31) And he said unto him, <u>If they hear not Moses and the prophets</u>, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

John 5:25 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall <u>hear</u> the voice of the Son of God: <u>and they that hear shall live</u>.

John 8:43-47 - 43) Why do ye not understand my speech? even because <u>ye cannot hear</u> my word. 47) <u>He that is of God heareth God's words</u>: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.

John 10:3 - To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.

John 10:27 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Acts 28:26-28 - 26) Saying, Go unto this people, and say, <u>Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not</u> <u>understand: and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive</u>: 27) For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. 28) Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it.

Rom 10:17 - So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Rom 10:14 - How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not <u>heard</u>? and how shall they <u>hear</u> without a preacher?

Rev. 1:3, 2:7,11,17,29 Rev. 3:6,13,20,22 Rev. 13:9 - "let him hear"

Luke 6:47 - Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like:

John 18:37 - Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

1 John 4:6 - We are of God: <u>he that knoweth God heareth us;</u> he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

Mark 9:7 - And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.

John 16:13 - Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; <u>but whatsoever he shall hear</u>, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

Heb 3:7 - Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,

James 1:19 - Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:

2 Tim 4:3-4 - 3) For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, <u>having itching ears</u>; 4) <u>And they shall turn away their ears from the truth</u>, and shall be turned unto fables.

Ezek 37:4 - Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

Eph. 1:4 - According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

John 13:18 - I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.

Acts 1:2 - Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

Acts 9:15 - (speaking of Paul) But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:

1 Cor 1:27-28 -27) But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; 28) And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are:

2 Thess 2:13 - But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

2 Tim 2:4 - No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

James 2:5 - Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

1 Peter 2:4 - To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious,

1 Peter 2:9 - But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Ps 25:12 - What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose.

Isa 66:4 - I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and chose that in which I delighted not.

Jer 51:17 - Every man is <u>brutish</u> by his knowledge; every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them.

Ezek 21:31 - And I will pour out mine indignation upon thee, I will blow against thee in the fire of my wrath, and deliver thee into the hand of <u>brutish men</u>, and skilful to destroy.

2 Peter 2:12 - But these, <u>as natural brute beasts</u>, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

Jude 10 - But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.
