James 2:1-4 - "thave not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ-- with respect(1) of persons. ²For if there come into your assembly a man with a gold ring in goodly apparel and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment; ³And you have respect(2) to him that weareth the gay clothing and say unto him, Sit thou here in the good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool; ⁴are ye not then partial in yourselves and become judges of evil thoughts?

(1)Respect- Greek: prosopolepsia- partiality; favoritism
(2)Respect- Greek: epiblepo- to fix the eyes upon with favor or partiality

Jeremiah 1:8 - Be not afraid of their faces

Faces - Hebrew: Paneh- the partial or surface

James is commanding the believer not to accept men by their outward appearance and by their material things. As well, we are not to reject the poor and needy because of their poverty. He charges us that when the church assembles, we are not to favor the rich and well-to-do in high positions of the church. Because of what the rich can do for us, we say to them, "sit here on the finance committee" or "here, have a seat on the deacons board." When we respect persons, James says we declare ourselves innocent of these evil thoughts. This sin is equivalent to adultery and murder (James 2:9-11). Paul said, "Set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church (I Cor. 6:4)".
