2 Tim 3:12 YEA, AND ALL THAT WILL LIVE GODLY IN CHRIST JESUS SHALL SUFFER PERSECUTION

Phil 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake; (given – the Greek word charizomai – to grant as a favor)

John 16:33 --In the world ye shall have tribulation:

1 Th 3:3 That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto.

1 Th 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction,

2 Cor 4:8 We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair;

9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

10 Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.

11 — we are alway delivered unto death — that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. — So then death worketh in us, but life in you.

Luke 9:23 And he said to

them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny (aparneomai – utterly contradict) himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

Luke 14:27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, CANNOT be my disciple.

The practice of "cutting asunder," mentioned in Matthew 24:51, has been known among various people in history. The writer of Hebrews mentions how some persecuted people were sawed in two (Hebrews 11:37), a practice here graphically illustrated by a sixteenth century artist. SUCH WAS THE FATE THAT TRADITION HAS ASSIGNED TO THE PROPHET ISAIAH.



Sawn asunder, torture death of Christians

Heb 11:35 - others were tortured --

36 And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

37 They were stoned, THEY WERE SAWN ASUNDER, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

38 (OF WHOM THE WORLD WAS NOT WORTHY:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

Acts 14:22 — we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

John 15:18 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you.

John 15:20 -- If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you;

1 Pet 3:14 if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye

1 Pet 4:12 Beloved think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

18 And if the righteous SCARCELY be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? The word SCARCELY is the Greek word MOLIS from the Greek word MOGIS meaning "WITH GREAT DIFFICULTY"
